On September 9th, 2025, at Nice Garden Hotel, Bumba, Caritas Byumba and World Vision Rwanda—Buranga Cluster held a partnership evaluation meeting for the Positive Deviance Hearth (PDH) project, implemented by Caritas Byumba with funding from World Vision International—Rwanda. The discussions focused on three key areas:

Communication:
