SECTION TWO: FRAMING AND DISCUSSION

MARKED

The event took place in the following context: According to the United Nations report "The state of food security and nutrition in the world 2024", in Peru 17.6 million people suffered from moderate or severe food insecurity (51.7% of the population), that is, they do not have regular access to sufficient, safe and nutritious food. Learn how the QaliWarma National School Feeding Program works, a program that serves approximately 4 million students in 64 thousand schools nationwide. The Public Agenda of NNAJ organizations, one of the problems it addresses is Climate Change, as a cause of food insecurity in the country. The WV ENOUGH Global Campaign that seeks to address hunger and child malnutrition as a result of the climate crisis.

DISCUSSION

The topic of discussion was: Food Safety in Schools. The questions were: How is the food service disseminated to the community? How do students participate in the food service in schools?

How does the food service work in schools, what can be improved?

SECTION THREE: RESULTS OF THE DIALOGUE

CHALLENGES

An agreement was signed to improve the Food Service in schools between girls, boys, adolescents and young people represented by the ANALIT and Nuestras Voces networks, and the Qali Warma State service (now Wasi Mikuna). The challenge for the future is for the Food Service to improve with the commitment of the State, the influence and monitoring of civil society,

URGENT ACTIONS

The signed agreements lead to urgent actions: Incorporate the participation of students in the food service as observers. Strengthen training for cooks to improve the preparation and varied use of food. Promote the dissemination of inclusive and user-friendly communication materials.

AREAS OF DIVERGENCE

Among the points of discussion that generated divergence are: The use of varied and nutritious foods in the school menu. Participation of girls and boys in the Food Service.

GENERAL SUMMARY

The event had important moments that should be highlighted, before, during and after the event:

Before the main national event, the national consultation on food security in schools was held, in the 24 regions of the country, where the opinions of 21 thousand students, teachers and parents were collected, with this information regional proposals were generated for the improvement of the service.

During the event, there were two important moments: 1. The two-day dialogue with representatives of the State Food Service Program, where the results of the consultation were analyzed, the students presented their regional processes, and the proposal for improving the service was developed. 2. At the time or on the main day, the main results of the national consultation and the proposal for improvement were presented. 3. The signing of the agreement for the improvement of the food service, signed by: director of the State program, representatives of organizations for girls, boys, adolescents and young people (ANALIT, Nuestras Voces, Ecolovers, MANTHOC, CCONNA), teacher of a School Food Committee (CAE), representative of the Roundtable for the Fight against Poverty, representative of the Ministry of Women and Vulnerable Populations.

Following the event, a work schedule is currently being developed between the Qali Warma State Programme, WVP and child, adolescent and youth organisations for the implementation of the agreements.

SECTION FOUR: PRINCIPLES OF COMMITMENT AND METHOD

PRINCIPLES OF COMMITMENT

The dialogue reflected the voice of the program users, including students and parents. There was informed participation. The consultation process was built in a participatory manner with organizations of girls, boys and adolescents, and spaces were provided so that students could dialogue with authorities and representatives of the State. Prior to the dialogue process, meetings were held with representatives of the State as well as with girls, boys and adolescents to present the entire Dialogue and Consultation process, with a schedule and key actions. Commitments were generated in these conversations. For this process, the methodology or model of Citizen Voice and Action was used, which allows dialogue between citizens and authorities with the purpose of improving public services, in this specific case the Food Service in Schools.

METHOD AND SCENARIO

For this process, the methodology or model of Citizen Voice and Action was used, which allows for dialogue between citizens and authorities with the purpose of improving public services, in this specific case the Food Service in Schools. The event was held in a location in the Miraflores district, in Lima, Peru, where approximately 50 students participated. The methodology was experiential, playful, reflective and expository.

ADVICE FOR OTHER CONVENTORS

It is important to collect the voices of citizens related to the problem to be addressed, because they are the ones who best know the situation of the needs, and also to call upon representatives of civil society. It is also important to involve citizen representatives in the dialogues in order to build alternative solutions to the problems with them.
